The Intellectual Property Research Institute of Australia (IPRIA), in association with Blake Dawson, is hosting a public seminar, to which you are invited.

One of the great unknowns of patent policy is how much infringement actually goes on, and how much of that infringement leads to enforcement of an informal or formal kind. IPRIA recently conducted a representative survey of over 3700 Australian inventors in order to estimate the prevalence of (alleged) infringement and what formal and informal steps were taken to stop the copying activities. We will present these findings along with a discussion of what can be done to improve the efficacy of patent enforcement in Australia.
